Students have access to advising, events, programs, employer partnerships, and online resources from their first day on campus, throughout their matriculation, and for their entire careers after graduation.

Lifelong Support

As a women's college, it is imperative that Beyond Barnard commit to providing **free lifelong resources** to its graduates. 20% of **Beyond Barnard's advising and programs** are dedicated to alums, who receive unfettered access to support.

Aligning with Barnard's Academic Mission

At Beyond Barnard, we believe that **your major doesn't dictate your career path** and that the skills you learn in the classroom should inform your work outside Barnard's gates — and vice versa. We work closely with the exceptional Barnard faculty and the academic departments to ensure that our resources draw from, and contribute to, the culture of academic excellence at the heart of a Barnard education.

Emphasizing Mentorship & the Barnard Community

Barnard's tradition of mentorship long precedes the founding of Beyond Barnard. We are proud to extend the institution's commitment to mentorship. More than **4,000 Barnard students and graduates** are already involved in Barnard Connect — Beyond Barnard's virtual mentoring platform. Students and alums have the opportunity to connect with one another for the purposes of career mentorships in five distinctive initiatives. By 2027, we are committed to growing the number of individuals engaged in these programs to **10,000 mentors**.

Partnerships

100% of Beyond Barnard's internship initiatives are supported by individual donors, corporate partners, and philanthropic organizations. Beyond Barnard and the Summer Research Institute together provided funding for **more than 475 students** with funding in 2023. By 2027, we are committed to guaranteeing that **any student who needs funding for an internship or research opportunity can secure it while enrolled at Barnard**.

An Emphasis on Mentorship & the Barnard Community

At Beyond Barnard, we know that success begins with a strong mentoring community and meaningful connections, particularly between students and the College's global network of 37,000 graduates. As mentors, guest speakers, Advisory Council members, and philanthropic contributors, Barnard graduates support Beyond Barnard initiatives – and the individuals who comprise this exceptional community. The investment of the community in Beyond Barnard's work sets the College apart. Here's how.

Mentorship Initiatives

Beyond Barnard connects students and alums to one another across five distinctive mentorship programs, involving alums, parents and families in our community, employers, and others in the success of students.



Barnard Connect

Since its launch in 2019, more than 4,600 Barnard students and graduates have joined this home-grown platform for virtual networking. Students and alums have the opportunity to take their conversations “into the real world” and stay in touch over time.

Executive Mentorship Program

Each year, cohorts of juniors and seniors are selected to meet with C-suite leaders across industries for discussions about leadership. These high-impact, small-group conversations help students gain insight into what it takes to spearhead a range of organizations across industries.



Mentors-in-Residence Program

The Mentors-in-Residence Program provides students with the chance to connect in small groups with distinguished visiting guests to Barnard. The setting helps foster a welcoming and inclusive environment for frank discussions of a range of topics.

Beyond Mentoring

Beyond Mentoring connects students with alums, parents, and friends of the College for short-term, paid project-based work. This initiative, originally established to provide students with substantive work experiences during the COVID-19 pandemic, has now supported more than 130 students.



Barnard Ambassador Program

The Barnard Ambassador Program is designed to support new graduates’ success in professional and academic environments. It connects alumnae at select companies and graduate schools to one another – and to the student community – for mentorship and information sharing.

What’s Next for Beyond Barnard Mentorship Programs?

By 2027, we’re committed to incorporating mentoring support into specific academic and career tracks and doubling the number of mentors in our programs by 2027. We’ll continue to strengthen and expand mentoring as a key element of Beyond Barnard’s partnerships across campus, with industry leaders, and at academic institutions. This work will not only support our students but also result in increased leadership opportunities for alums who wish to engage as mentors and community facilitators.



Facilitating relationships to employers is a critical part of Beyond Barnard's work. At this year's Non-Profit and Government Opportunities Fair, students had the opportunity to connect directly with visiting professionals. Roughly 40% of Barnard recent graduates pursue work in nonprofits, education, advocacy, and government.

Looking Ahead to 2023-24

Reimagining the Campus Career Fair

In 2018, Beyond Barnard expanded its career fairs to encompass guest speakers, panel discussions, and opportunities for students to connect with alums. This year, we will launch our first **Opportunities Conference**, connecting Barnard undergraduates directly with employers across industries in small-group settings, facilitating connections to alums, and hosting daylong conversations about recruiting, retaining, and advancing the next generation of students.

The Barnard Campus Internship Program

Each year, more than 1,000 Barnard students work in meaningful roles that help support the College. In addition to these roles, Beyond Barnard plans to bring more paid professional development programming, transparency in compensation, training for more than 200 campus supervisors, and more. The result: the **Barnard Campus Internship Program** – a dynamic community of students whose campus roles are preparing them for what comes after college.

Deepening Our Lifelong Commitment

Each year, the percentage of Beyond Barnard's effort dedicated to serving alums increases. It's a testament to the importance of providing lifelong career support to the ever-growing community of Barnard graduates. In 2023-24, Beyond Barnard will expand its capacity to assess and report on our work with alums while syncing our efforts with the College's coming Lifelong Learning initiatives.

Expanding Our Reach with Corporate Partners

Beyond Barnard aims to expand its portfolio of corporate partners, not only to provide opportunities for our students and alums but also to bring Barnard's faculty and staff expertise to bear on challenges related to gender, race, sustainability, and hiring Gen Z.



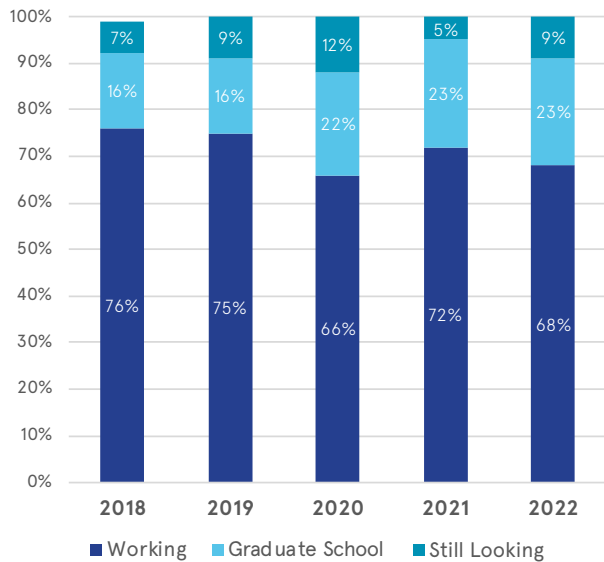

Key Indicators

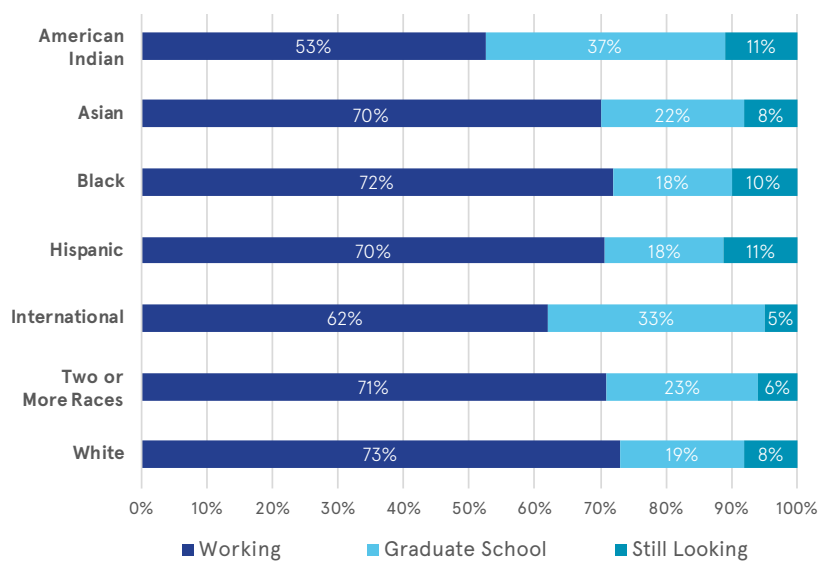
To mark Beyond Barnard’s five years, we launched two brand-new data dashboards that share statistics about the successes of the classes of 2018–2022.

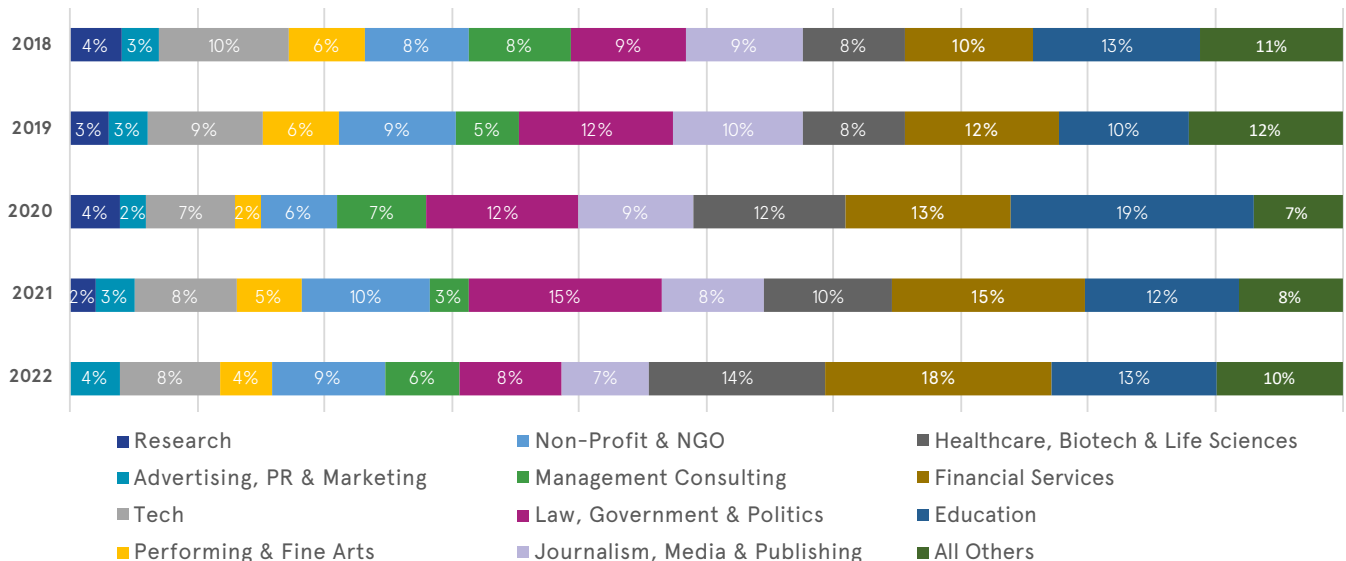
First Destination Outcomes, Classes of 2018–2022
