First-Year Experience courses can *not* “double-count” for other requirements

Distributional Requirements

Languages (2 courses)

Arts/Humanities (2 courses)

Social Sciences (2 courses)

Sciences (2 courses, 1 with a Laboratory)

Modes of Thinking

Quantitatively and Empirically (1 course)

Technologically and Digitally (1 course)

Through Global Inquiry (1 course)

Locally—New York City (1 course)

About Social Difference (1 course)

With Historical Perspective (1 course)

A single course may count for *no more than two of these categories*

Major

Varies by program: generally 9-14 courses

Senior Experience

Varies by program: thesis or other research or creative project

Electives

Number of courses will vary and may include a minor or prerequisites for professional school

Total: 122 credits = approximately 40 courses
