A double asterisk (**) indicates a major/program that is jointly administered by two departments. A triple asterisk (***) indicates a major that is completed only in conjunction with another major (double major only).

Degrees granted include all degrees granted in each department/program in October, February, or May of the given academic year. Students who double major are counted once in each of the departments/programs in which they earned a degree. Prior to 2024, students with a special or combined major were included in the count of the first or primary department that administered their major. From 2024 onwards, students with a special major will be reported separately, with the exception of data science and information science, which will be counted under the Computer Science Department.

Unduplicated headcount is the total number of students who earned a degree in the given year. This number counts students who double major only once and will be lower than the total degrees granted.
