CSTEP AT BARNARD COLLEGE 2021 – 2022



The Collegiate Science and Technology Entry Program (CSTEP) at Barnard College is a New York State funded program, designed to increase access for historically underrepresented minorities or economically disadvantaged students, who demonstrate interest in and show potential for, science, technology, engineering, mathematics (STEM), health-related fields or the licensed professions.

To be eligible for CSTEP, you must meet all of the required criteria listed below and complete the application for admission. For students being considered in the category of economically disadvantaged, you must also submit the required financial documentation.

To qualify for Barnard College CSTEP you must meet the following criteria:

- Be a U.S. citizen or Permanent Resident.
- Be a New York State resident.
- Have completed your first semester at Barnard College.
- Have a G.P.A. 2.85 or above, and
- Have an interest in a career in education, science, technology, psychology, engineering, mathematics

or other New York State licensed professions.

I understand that admission to Barnard College CSTEP is selective and includes consideration of both academic and financial information submitted to the Office of Opportunity Programs at kwindsor@barnard.edu (Barnard Hall, 1st Floor).

The next step in the admission process: An interview will be scheduled for all applicants that meet the criteria of the selection committee. This interview is part of the admission selection process, but does not guarantee admission.

If applicable, all required financial aid documentation must be completed and on file before the next step of the admission process.

- Meet with an Opportunity Programs Administrator
- Attend an orientation meeting prior to the start of the program if admitted


Services provided to students are academic counseling, skills development, enrichment activities, internship/research opportunities, graduate school preparation, and specialized workshops.
