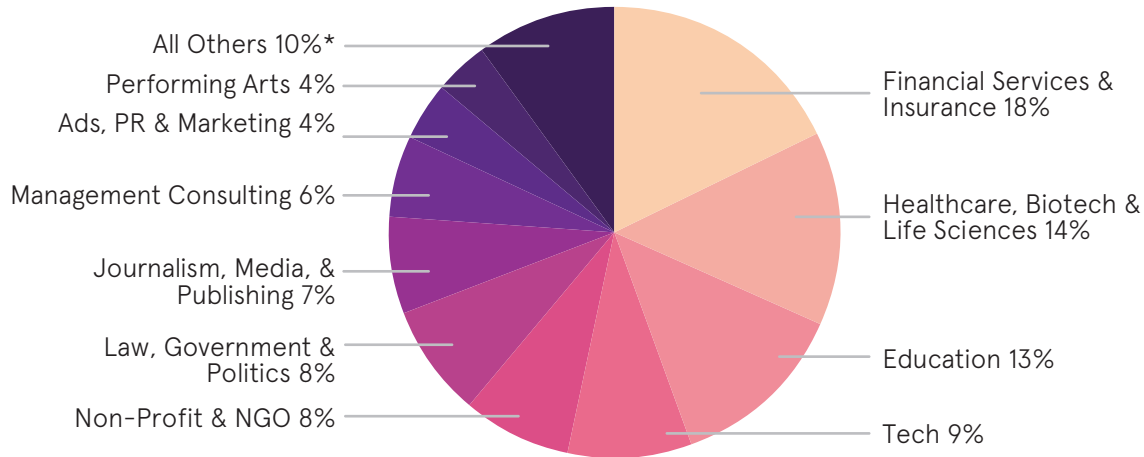


Barnard College Class of 2022 Six-Month Post-Graduate Outcomes
