# Mailman School of Public Health

The Mailman School of Public Health's 4+1 Pathway provides Barnard undergraduates with the opportunity to earn a Master of Public Health degree in one of six areas of concentration: Biostatistics, Environmental Health Sciences, Epidemiology, Health Policy and Management, Population and Family Health, or Sociomedical Sciences.

All 4+1 students complete a robust core curriculum that engages with research methods, social determinants of health, and global and developmental perspectives on public health, among other topics.

4+1 Pathway students have the opportunity to participate in public health research with global implications, and all students complete a practicum in order to apply the knowledge they gain in the classroom to real-world problems. This experience helps students to put their degrees to work in a wide range of settings, including healthcare, government, consulting, nonprofits, and education.

The Accelerated 4+1 Pathways allow students to combine an undergraduate liberal arts education at Barnard with a master's degree at one of the world's preeminent research universities. Application fees and GRE requirements are waived for Barnard students. Students admitted to the Accelerated 4+1 Pathways have access to Beyond Barnard advising and special events hosted for their cohorts.
